Session 3 Assignment

Children's Needs, Trauma Informed Practice, and Service Delivery

Revisit the community in which you carried out the Community Assessment (Assignment 1) and the FBCD Assessment (Assignment 2). This time, go deeper to focus on and assess children's needs. Apply the concepts and practice the skills learned in Session 3.

Answer the following to complete Assignment 3 on Child Welfare

1. Describe what already exists in communities that support families and children and the challenges they face, using UNCRC and ACRWC as guides.
2. Describe how the assets, resources and skills you have identified in families and the community can be used to address the challenges of assuring the well-being of children.
3. Describe the way in which children's input can be involved in addressing these challenges.
4. Determine which Essential Element(s) in Trauma-Informed Practice is/are being challenged in the community. Develop a strategy to address it/them using ABCD and FBCD.
5. Develop a plan to coordinate service providers to support children's safety, health, education and well-being in harmony with UNCRC and ACRWC in the community. Discuss how this plan might be implemented through the work of your organization in the community or through the community.
6. Develop a plan to heighten community and family awareness of the impact of trauma on children and ways to address and manage the consequences of that trauma. Discuss how this plan might be implemented through the work of your organization in the community or through the community.
7. What additional questions need to be answered about how to use these concepts, skills, and ideas effectively in the settings where you work?
